	Community members voiced their frustration over the lack of advance notice regarding the cancellation of elections scheduled to take place on May 4th during the annual meeting. They also raised concerns about the potential for future elections to be canceled when individuals express dissent. Additionally, they questioned the justification for the decision, debating whether it was a wise course of action and how such choices might affect future voting processes.	Policies will be developed to ensure that community members receive timely communication when significant meeting agendas are modified. The Board of Directors will deliberate internally on whether canceling important events due to unfounded circumstances is appropriate. The Board of Directors will establish a formal procedure for handling written complaints moving forward.

9	Community agenda and meeting notes A concern was raised regarding the lack of accessible masjid agendas and meeting notes. Without a structured way to share key discussions and decisions, community members are left with the unrealistic expectation of listening to lengthy meeting recordings—often spanning three hours—just to stay informed. To address this, a suggestion was made to enhance communication by either: • Sending regular emails containing meeting agendas and minutes • Posting agendas and minutes directly on the masjid's website	<ol> <li>Advice for Implementation:         <ol> <li>Designate a Responsible Team – Assign someone (or a small committee) to summarize meetings efficiently and ensure timely dissemination of information.</li> <li>Utilize Email &amp; Website Updates – Create a standard practice for posting agendas before meetings and sharing minutes after they conclude.</li> <li>Consider Summarized Notes – Instead of full transcripts, concise summaries highlighting key discussions, decisions, and action items would make it easier for the community to stay engaged.</li> <li>Encourage Community Feedback – Allow members to provide input on the effectiveness</li> </ol> </li> </ol>



10	Iftar seating This concern was raised last year without a policy implementing change. A concern was raised regarding the seating arrangements for women during Iftars in the masjid with women required to sit upstairs and men in the lower level. Issues: 1) Women left without a sense of security and 2) Dissatisfaction with families and/or friends wanting to sit together. The seating arrangement issue was raised during last year's community meeting, yet the same problem continues to occur. The Board has not created nor inclusion.	of these updates to ensure they meet the needs of the masjid's community. Enhancing transparency fosters greater engagement and strengthens trust within the community. The concern about security when women are seated upstairs without men around is valid, and the masjid should consider and implement safety measures to ensure a secure environment for all attendees. The seating arrangement continues to cause concern. It is the community's expectation that masjid leadership find a workable solution that accommodates both tradition and the needs of the community, i.e. successfully implementing mixed-family seating areas while still respecting Islamic guideline.
